

FOUNDERS SCHOLARSHIP 2020 APPLICATION FORM

Thank you for applying for a Cornerstone Credit Union Founders Scholarship. Since the program's inception in 1998, Cornerstone Credit Union has awarded thousands of dollars in scholarships to area youth. Education is a key element of the credit union mission and is vital to our community's and economy's success. For 2020, six (6) recipients will each be awarded a one-time scholarship in the amount of \$1,500 from Cornerstone Credit Union.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicant or parent must currently be a member of Cornerstone Credit Union. Applicant must currently be a high school senior who plans to enroll as a full-time student at a university, junior college or trade school in the fall of 2020.

Applicants must submit a **completed Cornerstone Credit Union Founders Scholarship Application form** which includes the following information:

- A 1,000 word or less answer to the Essay question provided in application form.
- An academic letter of recommendation from your school principal, counselor or advisor (cannot be a family member).
- A personal letter of recommendation from an adult in your community who knows you well and can attest to your personal qualities and abilities. It should not be written by a family member or causal acquaintance.
- School transcript showing cumulative grade point average for current year.
- A list of your volunteer activities, part-time jobs, clubs, academic awards and/or any other community involvement over the last four years (high school).

AWARD CRITERIA

Awards will be based on academic achievement, writing assessments, recommendations, and transcripts, as well as the student's potential based on character and involvement. On a 4.0 scale, a G.P.A. of 3.0 or higher is recommended. Applications will be judged by the Cornerstone Credit Union Founders Scholarship Committee.

DEADLINE

The completed application must be submitted by or postmarked on or before February 28, 2020. SUBMIT BY EMAIL by clicking on the SUBMIT button at the end of this application and attaching required documents to email; OR print and mail completed form and required documents to:

CERTIFICATION AND RELEASE AUTHORIZATION

Please make sure to submit your completed application form with two (2) letters of recommendation, your school transcript, your list of activities and awards, and your essay (if not included in application form). If you do not submit these items, you will not be eligible to receive a scholarship. Application form must be signed by applicant and his/her parent or guardian (below).

By submitting this form, I authorize Cornerstone Credit Union to release the scholarship application information provided to the Founders Scholarship Committee for the purpose of determining my eligibility as a scholarship recipient.
